At its regularly scheduled Board meeting of February 25, 2020, the Hawaii Kai Neighborhood Board took action by a unanimous vote to support the Waimanalo community's efforts to protect Sherwood Forest. The City and County's Waimanalo Bay Beach Park Master Plan would destroy the last remaining coastal forest of its size on Oahu.

The area is in a Coastal Zone Management Area and is on the State's Historic Register, having iwi buried there. The deconstruction of Sherwood Forest despoils one of Oahu's most beautiful beach areas, eliminates vital green space and destroys plant and animal life, including endangered hoary bats, endangered ground-nesting birds such as shearwaters, and indigenous plants.
