## Candidate and Elected Official Pledge to Support the Protection of Sherwood Forest

I support projects by the City and County of Honolulu that:

- (1) are planned with adequate community input and engagement, allow the community to actively take part in determining its own needs and priorities, are open and transparent, and include local residents in decisions affecting their neighborhoods;
